HOW NOT TO CONTRACT HIV

Do you know that there is a way to avoid contracting HIV?

Using condoms and PrEP

- A condón is always important: it protects against the VIH and all the other infections of sexual transmission.
- **PrEP** stands for prophylaxis prior to exposure
- **It is a prevention:** it consists in taking anti-retroviral tablets BEFORE having sexual relationships, which avoid that the HIV virus enters in contact with it, infecting your body
- **To make PrEP you need a recipe from an infectologist:** contact the infection control centers in your city to know more!

IS A PERSON WITH HIV INFECTION CONTAGIOUS?

Not all people infected with HIV are contagious. **It is called U=U**

U=U means that a person with HIV infection who takes the therapy stably and has an **undetectable value of virus in the blood (Undetectable) cannot transmit the virus (Untransmittable), even with unprotected sex.**

This is why it is absolutely important to do the TEST. Knowing if you have contracted HIV is essential to take good care of yourself and don't pass it on to others.

If you are infected with HIV and have any concerns or questions, talk to the infectious disease doctor who follows you!
